Support local & international humanitarian initiatives & appeals, aimed at assisting those affected by fire or disaster.



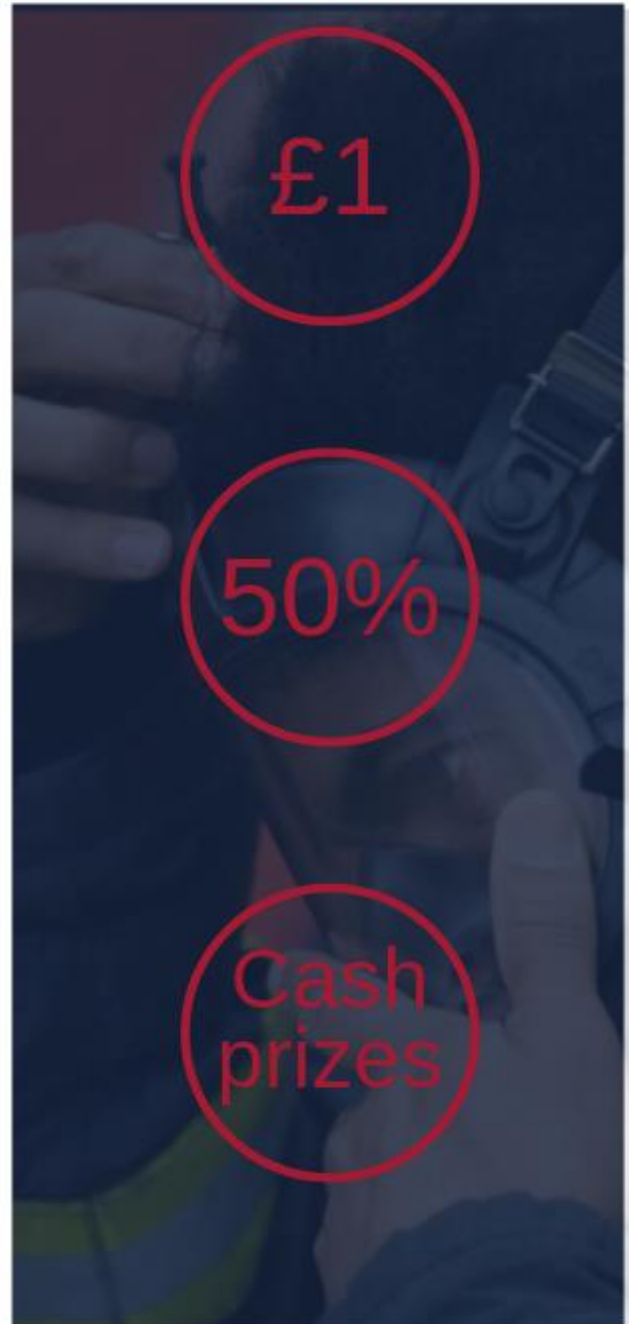
MEMORIALS & REMEMBRANCE

- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify the organisation.
